Metrics About Academic Organizations

AAHRPP is pleased to present the 2020 metrics for Human Research Protection Program (HRPP) performance. AAHRPP provides these data to help research organizations, researchers, sponsors, government agencies, and participants identify and support high-performing practices for HRPPs.

These metrics are collected from Annual Reports, as well as Step 1 and Step 2 applications, submitted by accredited academic organizations.

All the quantitative data were derived from the most recent reports by AAHRPP organizations.

Data were selected based on what most accurately reflected academic organizations in 2020.

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
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
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Where Accredited Academic Organizations are Based

This graph shows where academic organizations conduct or review research. The majority conduct or review


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








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


Relying on External IRBs/ECs

Use of external IRBs/ECs by academic organizations with internal IRBs/ECs







Compensating IRB/EC Members

Active Studies Overseen: All Academic Organizations




This chart shows the median number of active studies that academic organizations conduct or review by type of review.

Active Studies Per IRB/EC




This chart shows the median number of active studies academic organizations oversee based on the number of IRBs/ECs they have.




Review Times: All Review Times




IRB/EC Review Times: Expedited Review


